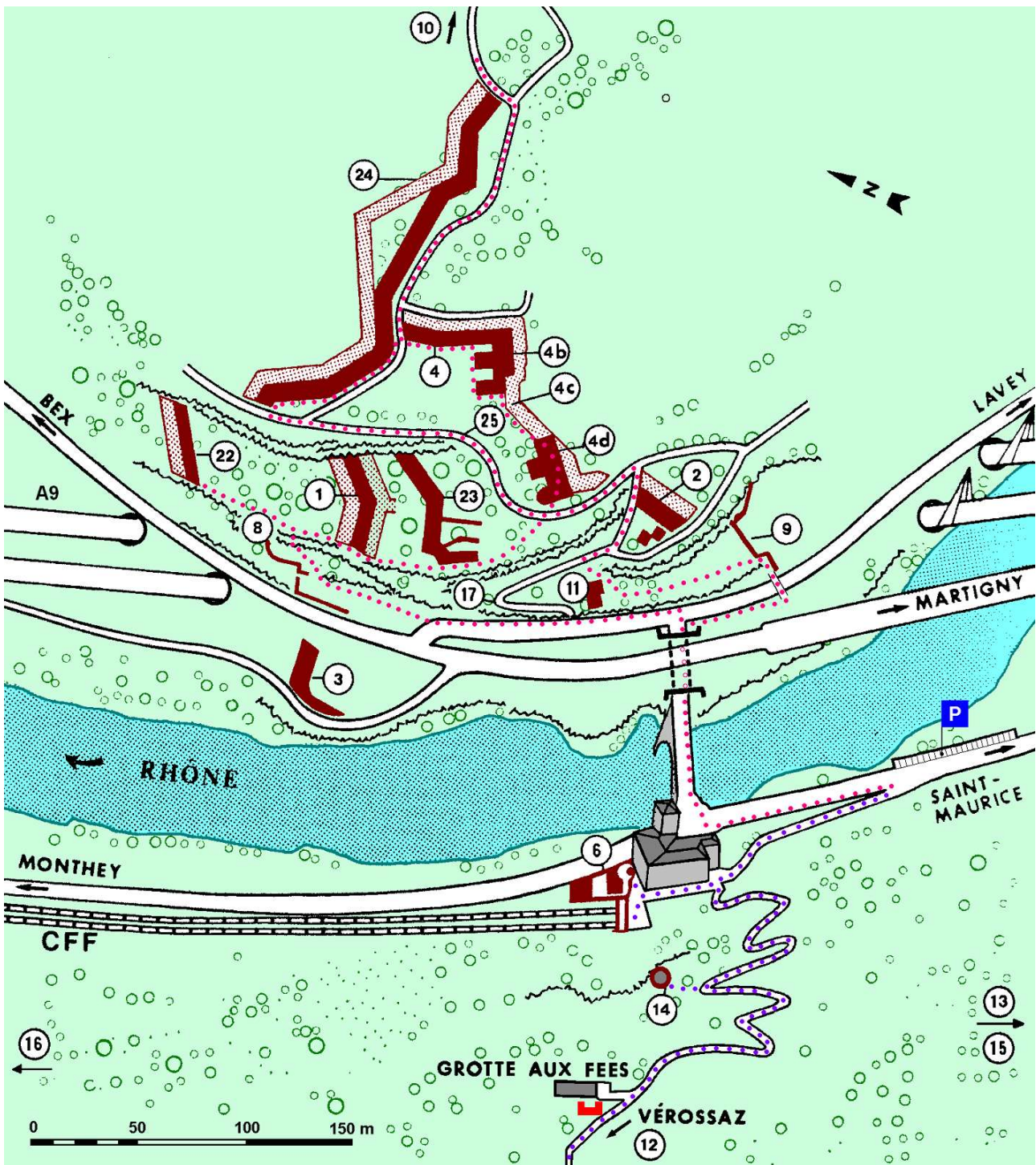


# Dufour-fortresses: Visit
